**Plug and Abandonment Summary:**

- Plug #1** with 48 sxs (56.64 cf) Class B cement from 1320' to 672' to cover the Pictured Cliffs and Fruitland perforations and tops. Tag TOC at 784'.
- Plug #2** with 40 sxs (47.2 cf) Class B cement from 406' to surface to cover the Kirtland top and surface casing shoe.
- Plug #3** with 20 sxs Class B cement top off casings and install P&A marker with coordinates N 36° 28' 33.60" / W 108° 2' 32.64".

**Plugging Work Details:**

11/28/16 Rode rig and equipment to location. Spot in and RU. Check well pressures: tubing and bradenhead 0 PSI and casing 25 PSI. X-over to rod tools. LD polish rod, rods and rod pump. X-over to tubing tools. Blow well down. ND wellhead. NU BOP. PU on 2-3/8" tubing. LD tubing hanger. PU 1 jnt and tag at 1320'. TOH and tally 2-3/8" 4.7#, J-55 tubing, 39 jnts prod, 1 jnt workstring 1320'. TIH to 1320'. Spot plug #1 with calculated TOC at 672'. SI well. SDFD.

11/30/16 Open up well; no pressures. RU relief lines. TIH and tag at 784'. Establish circulation. Pressure test casing to 800 PSI, OK. RU pump to bradenhead immediately water started coming out side surface casing. Looked at CBL, estimated TOC at 28'. PUH to 406'. Establish circulation. Spot plug #2 with TOC at surface. ND BOP. Dig out wellhead. Write Hot Work Permit. Cut off wellhead. Found cement at surface in 4-1/2" casing and tag on backside down 36'. Spot plug #3 to top off casings and install P&A marker with coordinates N 36° 28' 33.60" / W 108° 2' 32.64". RD and MOL.
