1. Set blanking plug in packer and test tubing.
2. If tubing leak, POOH with tubing and replace.
3. If tubing held, POOH with injection equipment.
4. RIH with work string and packer. Confirm well failed MIT due to packer leak or hole in casing.
5. Repair source of leak.
6. RIH with injection packer and set at a depth of ~5539'.
7. Circulate packer fluid and perform MIT. Notify NMOCD 48 hours prior to test.


