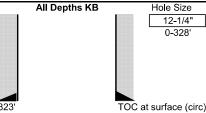

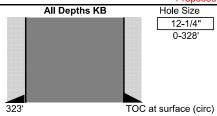

- Rig up cementing equipment. Fill PVC with fluid and confirm circulation.
- Pump ~141 sx Class G cmt at 15.8 ppg & 1.15 cuft/sx (or equivalent), with ~17 bbls of mix water. No displacement.
- TOOH & LD PVC. Top off with cement as needed.
- Cut off wellhead and install a P&A marker
