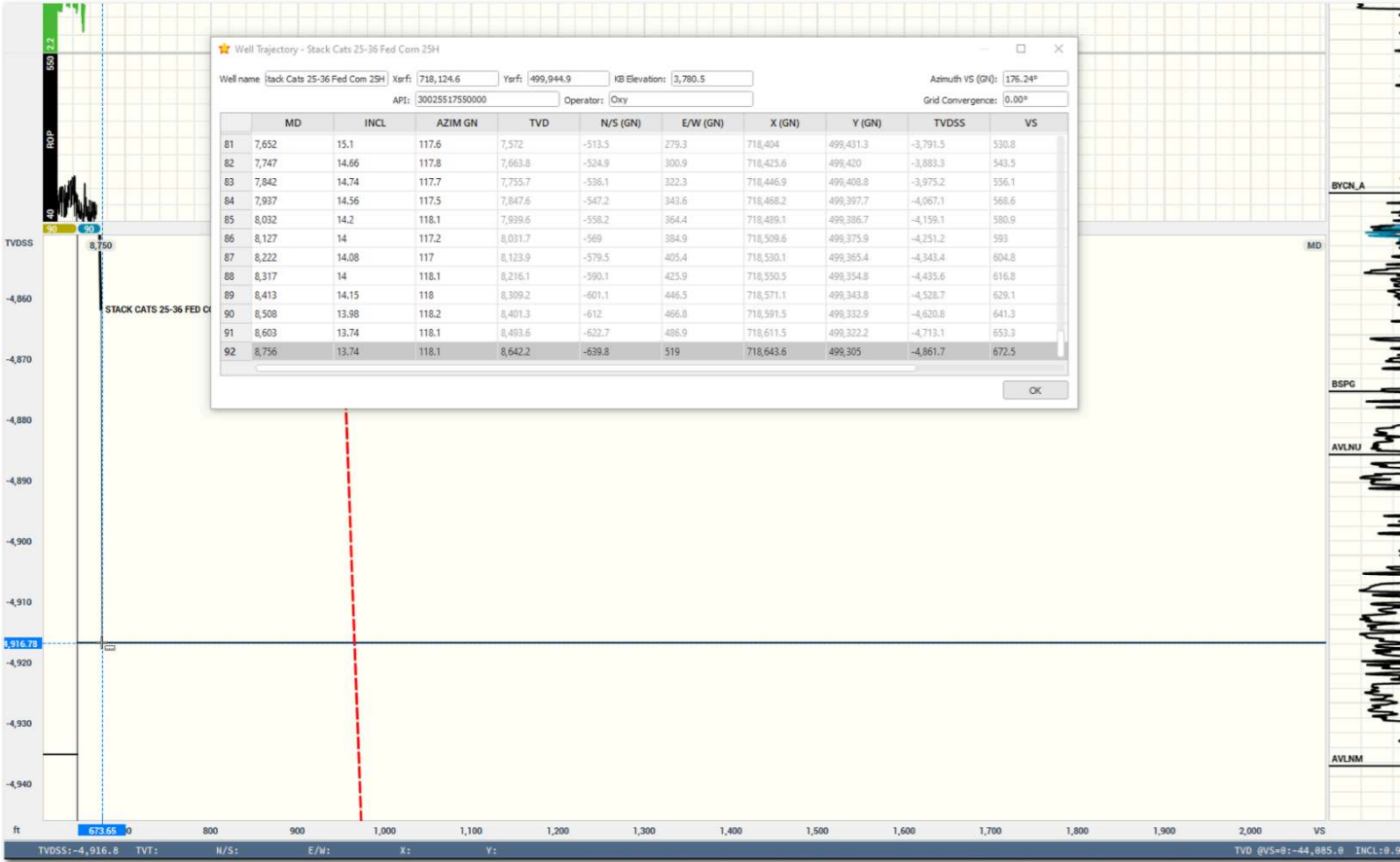
Thanks for the call earlier today.

As discussed on the phone, one of the rigs that is drilling in the Red Tank Area has made it all the way down to ~55ft TVD above the BoneSpring Top and is having to trip for downhole tool failure.

Latest Sundry has us setting casing into the BS top. Our call earlier and this request is to deviate from the latest approved design, allowing us to set casing just above the BS top.

- Breakdown:
- We have not seen losses on this well, even the shallow losses that were mentioned and covered last week.
 - We have a lightweight MW that will be used for the entire production section (8.0 – 8.5 ppg)
 - Production Cement job will be a single stage job with 11ppg lead cement that will be lifted to get our overlap with intermediate casing
 - FIT is planned is 11.0ppg EMW. Latest ECD when we were drilling was close to 10ppg
 - We feel that we have a high chance of having a competent shoe where we are planning to set at.
 - As discussed, we will be setting in the Brushy so we can not be 100% sure, we will inform you if we have any issues while performing FIT
 - We will get with Leslie to submit a formal Sundry for this change.
