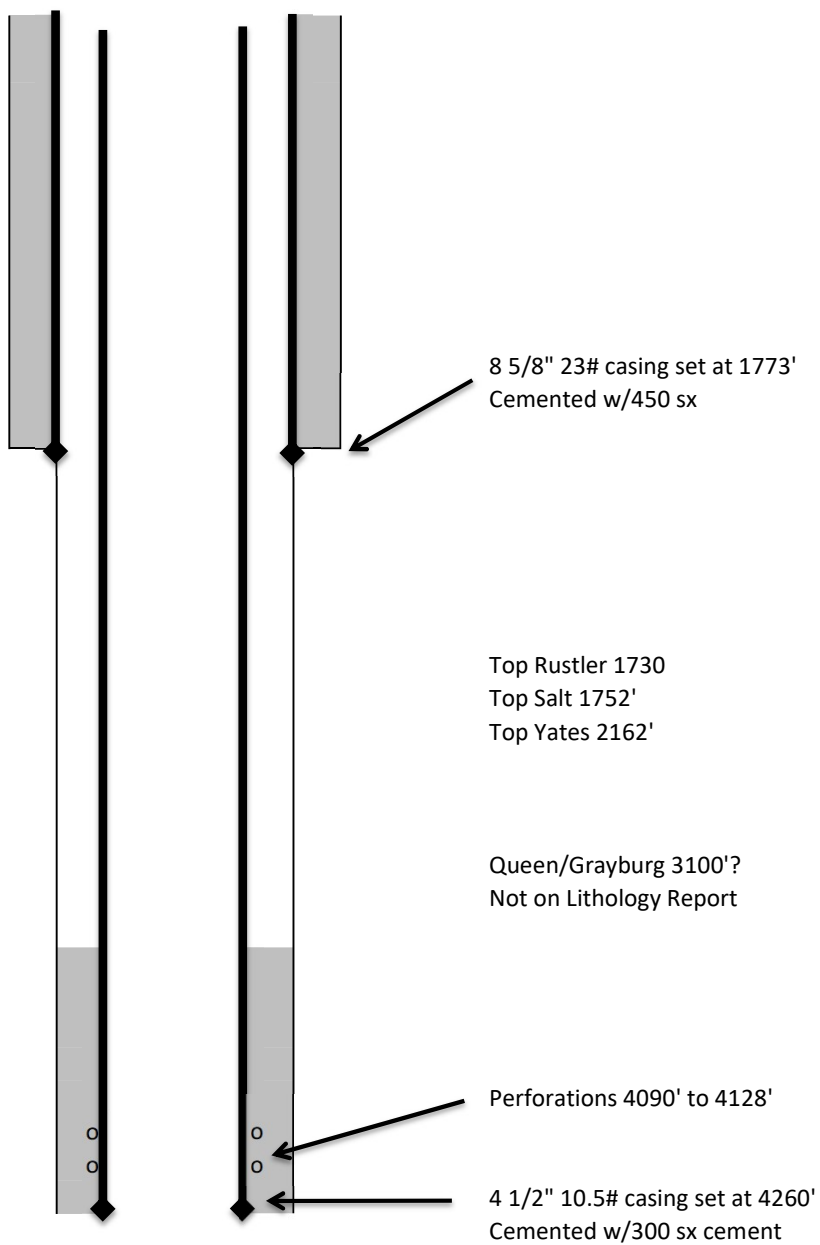

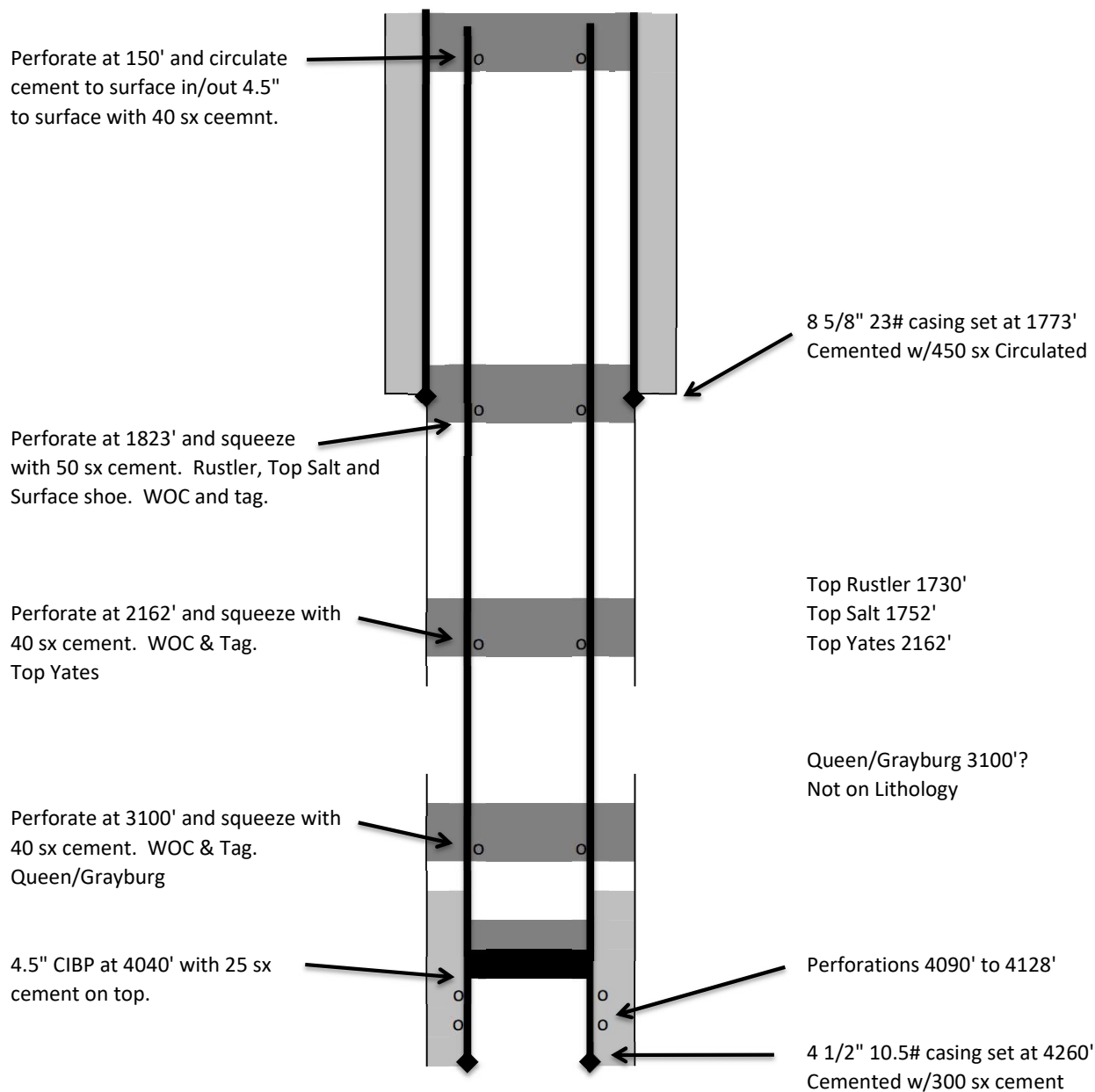
**Proposed Plugging Procedures
Cano Petro of New Mexico, Inc.

1. Lay down rods and POOH with tubing.
2. Set 4.5" CIBP at 4040. Circulate MLF and casing to 500#. Spot 25 sx Class C cement on top of CIBP.
3. Run CBL. Adjust procedures accordingly.
4. Perforate at 3100' and squeeze with 40 sx cement. Queen/Grayburg. This is an estimated depth due to these formations not being listed on the lithology report.
5. Perforate at 2162' and squeeze with 40 sx cement. WOC and tag. Top Yates.
6. Perforate at 1823' and squeeze with 50 sx cement. WOC and tag above 1680'. Top Salt, Rustler and Surface Shoe.
7. Perforate at 150' and circulate cement to surface in/out 4.5" casing.
8. Remove wellhead and ensure good cement to surface in both strings of casing.
9. Install below ground marker.

Conditions of Approval**

- 1. Operator shall place a CIBP at 4,040' (50'-100' above top perf) and spot 25sx of Class C cement on top. WOC and TAG.**
- 2. Operator shall perf at 3,032' and squeeze cement class C cement to 2,788' to seal the Queen and Grayburg Formations. WOC and TAG.**
- 3. Operator shall perf at 2,210' and squeeze cement class C cement to 2,049' to seal the Yates and bottom of Salt. WOC and TAG.**
- 4. Operator shall perf at 1,823' and squeeze cement class C cement to 1,650' to seal the top of Salt, Rustler and 8-5/8" casing shoe. WOC and TAG.**
- 5. Operator shall perf at 150' and squeeze cement class C cement to surface as proposed.**
- 6. Dry hole marker must be below ground.**
- 7. Surface reclamation will need to be completed once the well bore has been plugged. Please contact rflores@blm.gov for additional information.**
- 8. See attached for general plugging stipulations.**
- 9. See attached for New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's plugging guidelines.**
