SWEPI LP proposes to close the drilling (reserve) pit at the subject well location and re-contour the ground surface in the pit area for future drilling and completion use.

SWEPI LP will:

- 1) Remove all solids and synthetic liners from the drilling (reserve) pit for off-site disposal at an OCD-approved facility. As needed, prior to transport for disposal, construct and operate a drying pad (minimum 20 mil HDPE liner and soil berms) to be used to evaporate excess moisture from the excavated pit contents.
- 2) Collect five-point composite soil sample(s) from underlying soils, and discrete soil samples from underlying soils in areas suspected of releases.
- 3) Submit soil samples for chemical analysis of benzene, total BTEX, TPH, GRO and DRO combined, and chlorides.
- 4) Backfill the pit with compacted soil materials.
- 5) Re-contour the ground surface in the pit area to match the existing grade of the well pad.
- 6) Prepare and submit a closure report to OCD, including laboratory analytical reports and post-closure Location Photos.
