Julio State Well No. 1 API No. 30-025-35889 Unit D, Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 39 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico DK-Abo (Oil 15200), and DK-Drinkard (Oil 15390) Pools

Dear Ms. Crawford:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303.A. of the Division Rules and Regulations to permit the above-described well to commingle production from the subject pools in the wellbore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303.C., and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the zones is hereby placed in abeyance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303C.(1), the maximum amount of oil and gas that may be produced from the well shall be determined by Division Rules and Regulations.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be as follows. These percentages shall be amended only with permission of the Hobbs District Office and copied in writing to the Division office in Santa Fe.

DK-Abo Oil Pool	Oil-33%	Gas-33%
DK-Drinkard Oil Pool	Oil-67%	Gas-67%

REMARKS: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
