Dear Mr. Ballesteros:

Reference is made to your request received in the Santa Fe office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 5, 2004, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above-referenced injection well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on this well on February 23 and March 29, 2004. The test results have been reviewed and we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

Without modifying the tubing size or type in the well, you are authorized to inject **water at or below 2,000 psi surface injection pressure.**

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
