Gentlemen,

Reference is made to the herein enclosed NMOCD Administrative Orders NSP-194 (dated 10/22/1955) and NSP-194-A (dated 05/27/1998). Administrative Order NSP-194 approved the non-standard, 160-acre Hansen State Eumont proration unit consisting of the NE/4 Section 16, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. After an eight-year shut-in period, Doyle Hartman returned the Hansen State No. 4 to active producing status in April, 1998. When it was returned to production, the Hansen State No. 4 was a Eumont Oil well. This situation made it necessary to dedicate 40 acres from the non-standard, 160-acre Hansen State Eumont proration unit to the Hansen State No. 4 Eumont Oil well, hence Administrative Order NSP-194-A was approved. Administrative Order NSP-194-A approved the non-standard, 120-acre Hansen State Eumont proration unit consisting of the N/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 Section 16, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. In May, 2001, the Hansen State No. 4 was recompleted as a Eumont Gas well.

By copy of this letter, Doyle Hartman hereby makes application for the amendment of Administrative Order NSP-194-A from 120 acres back to the original 160 acres. Application is also made for the simultaneous dedication of the Hansen State No. 4 Eumont Gas well to the non-standard, 160-acre Hansen State Eumont proration unit.

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


