Dear Mr. Afghahi:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on May 20, 2004 to increase the surface injection pressure on the Charlcia A. Taylor Well No. 1. This request is based on fracture data from wells in this area. The results of the fracture data show that increasing the injection pressure for the Charlcia A. Taylor Well No. 1 should not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
