RE: Injection Pressure Increase

Genesis State SWD Well No. 3 Lea County, New Mexico

Dear Ms. Crawford:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on June 3, 2004 to increase the surface injection pressure on the Genesis State SWD Well No. 3. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well during May, 2004. The results of the step rate test show that an increase in the surface injection pressure for this well is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
