

Request for Surface Commingling of Pools/Leases and Off-Lease Measurement/Sale of Gas Production Richardson Operating Company's ROPCO 15 Gathering System

San Juan County, New Mexico

Richardson Operating Company is writing to request your administrative approval to surface commingle natural gas production form the ROPCO GW PC 15-2 West Kutz Pictured Cliffs well with production from the ROPCO GW A PC B FC 15-1 a down-hole commingled West Kutz Pictured Cliffs / Basin Fruitland Coal well, for the mutual conservation benefit of centralized compression through Richardson's centralized electric compressor station located on the ROPCO GW PC 15-2 location and to get produced natural gas to the sales meter.

Application is, also, being made for off-lease sales measurement and production allocation to proportionally distribute production value and volume to the respective wells through a Central Delivery Point sales meter, also, being located on the ROPCO GW PC 15-2 location, SW/SE Section 15, T29N, R13W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Production allocation, to proportionally distribute "beneficial use" gas will be made from the CDP meter to the wells involved. In the event a line blow-down is necessary or other gas loss occurs from the gathering system, Richardson will determine the total volume lost using industry procedures for the conditions existing at the time of the loss. The total volume lost will be allocated to the individual wells affected using percentage of total volume factors determined for the wells.

Attachment No.1 is a Lease/Pool map showing the lease number and location of the lease plus the 2 existing wells operated by Richardson Operating Company that contribute production to the gas gathering system. This map also places all flow-lines, compressor and CDP equipment.

Attachment No. 2 is a schematic diagram clearly identifying the compressor and CDP equipment utilized. Net gas volume for the ROPCO GW PC 15-2 is determined by the Subtraction Method – the difference between the volume recorded at the CDP meter and the volume recorded at the orifice type allocation meter located on the ROPCO GW A PC B FC 15-1 location. The mechanical integrity of the gathering system has been demonstrated through pressure testing - the pressure charts are available for review.

Attachment No. 3 lists estimated or monthly production of each contributing well and BTU content along with other information requested by the NMOCD.

Attachment No. 4 is Pool Commingling production information requested.

Attachment No. 5 is Richardson Operating Company's Allocation Procedure.

Attachment No. 6 is a list of all parties owning any interest in any of the production to be commingled. Richardson Operating Company has, on or before the date that this application was mailed to the NMOCD, sent notification to each of the interest owners by submitting a copy of the application and all attachments thereto, by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them that any objection must be filed in writing with the Santa Fe office of the NMOCD within 20 days from the date the division received this application. Attachment No. 7 is a copy of the notice sent by certified mail to all interest owners. All notice letters have been sent by certified, return receipt mail and upon receiving the receipts, copies will be forwarded to the NMOCD. Attachment No. 8 is a copy of the "Affidavit of Publication" which was published in The Daily Times to further provide notice to all interest owners, anticipating that out of the volume of notices mailed by certified mail, there will be some receipts not returned.

As evidenced by the production allocation procedure (attachment No. 5) and the pool commingling production information (attachment No. 4), production volume will be properly allocated based upon quality and quantity.

The wells involved with this system typically have bottom hole pressures of 150 psi or less. The transporter's pipelines available for gas delivery typically have pressures in the 180-250 psi range, therefore these wells have no economic life without the use of compression – as long as the compression cost does not exceed the net revenue received from the production.

The minimal charges against lease production for "beneficial use" gas are far exceeded by the production rate increases due to the conservative benefit of centralized compression where compressor lease expenses decrease as the number of units employed decrease.

Richardson Operating Company is the sole operator participating in this project.




Wells / Leases / Pools - Map
