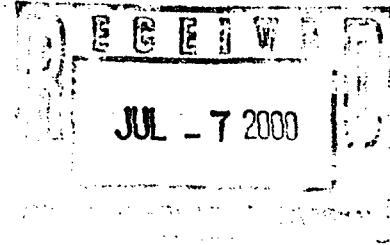

This is an airphoto of the area of Vastar's Carracas 25A #16. You have, or will have an NSL request for it in the Basin FC.

The proposed well location is in the west central area, west off the southern road where it turns south westerly. This is in P, 25, 32N, 5W.

The northern road with the switchbacks is from a well permitted in 1953: Stanolind Oil Co. #2 in H,25, 32N, 5W. It maybe insufficient for modern equipment needs, but it is an existing disturbance and would be a standard quarter section for BFC development.
