I have reviewed your application dated April 21, 2003 for authorization to surface commingle Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres and Undesignated Delaware production on the Coyote State Lease in Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Additional clarification is necessary prior to approving the application.

- 1) Is the ownership between the pools on this lease identical? If so, the application should be filed on Form C-103, complete with all of the attachments as required by Rule 19.15.5.303.B.3.(b);
- 2) Your application states that there may be wells on this lease that are capable of production in excess of top unit allowable. If this is the case, these well(s) must be separately measured prior to commingling.
