David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 F (2) adopted on January 18, 1996, of an unorthodox gas well location for its Ralph Davis Well No. 1 to be recompleted as a wildcat Queen gas well at an unorthodox well location 990 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This location is unorthodox because it is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provide for gas wells on 160-acre spacing units to be located no closer than 660 feet to any boundary of such tract.

This well was drilled to test the San Andres formation, East Hobbs-San Andres Pool. Since the well has been drilled, this unorthodox location is required by topographic conditions. It watered out and has been shut-in since the early 1970's. Arrington plans to re-enter the well, repair a casing leak, plug back to

approximately 4000 feet, and complete it in the Queen formation. The unorthodox location is the result of this recompletion in an existing wellbore.

Pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 D (2)(b) and (c) adopted on January 18, 1996, David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. also seeks administrative approval of a 51.95 acre non-standard gas spacing and proration for the Ralph Davis Well No. 1 to be comprised of the southeast quarter equivalent of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 39 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.


This non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is necessary because of a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Surveys. This unit is comprised of contiguous lots on the New Mexico-Texas border which lie wholly within a single governmental quarter section and are joined by a common side. They were also advised that if no objections were received by the Division within twenty days, the Division Director could approve the application.
