Reference is made to your application received on December 20, 1973, requesting exception to Oil Conservation Commission Rule 303-A and permission to commingle in the well-bore production from the Drinkard and Wantz Abo Pools.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to provisions of Rule 303-C, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above.

In accordance with provisions of Rule 303-C total commingled oil production from the subject well shall not exceed 50 barrels per day and total water production shall not exceed 100 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily shall be determined by multiplying 2,000 by the top unit allowable for the Wantz-Abo Pool.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: 4% Lowar Pool: 96%



Pursuant to Rule 303-C-3, the commingling authority granted by this order may be rescinded by the Secretary-Director if, in his opinion, conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
