Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the subject well to permit the commingling of production from both pools in the well-bore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303-C, and Order No. R-5114 and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: Oil 16% Cas 20% Lower Pool: Oil 84% Gas 30%

Pursuant to Rule 303-C 5 and Order No. R-5114, the commingling authority granted hereby may be rescinded

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by the Secretary-Director if, in his opinion, conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
