Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the subject well to permit the commingling of production from both pools in the well-bore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303-C, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303-C, total commingled oil production from the subject well shall not exceed 80 not exceed 100 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which amount allowable for the East Lusk-Wolfcamp Pool.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:



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Upper Pool: 011 29% - Gas 2% Lower Pool: 011 71% - Gas 98%

Pursuant to Rule 303C 5, the commingling authority granted by this order may be rescinded by the Secretary-Director if, in his opinion, conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
