

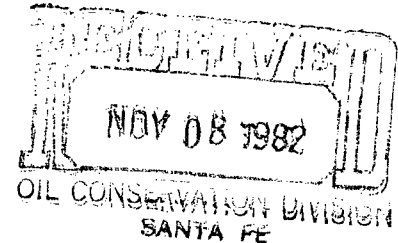

Commingling Application for the Jicarilla Gas Com 35 D No. 1  
1650' FSL x 1040' FWL, Section 12, T24N, R5W  
Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

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The application for the commingling of the subject well was initially sent on July 12, 1982. On September 27, 1982, we were notified by Michael Stogner that the application had never been received. He also noted that all offset operators had responded favorably to our request. A duplicate application was mailed to your office, in care of Michael Stogner, on September 29, 1982. We have scheduling requirements that dictate this well has to be turned on November 12, 1982. Therefore, we need immediate notification of whether our commingling application has been approved or disapproved.

The subject well has no concerns which would disqualify commingled production. There is no disparity of bottom hole pressures. Waste or formation damage is unlikely to occur and the correlative rights of all the parties involved will not be violated.
