Dear Mr. Lehrman:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application (administrative application reference No. pSEM0-434947476) filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on December 14, 2004; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe: all concerning Lance Oil & Gas Company's ("Lance") request for a non-standard 92.30-acre gas spacing unit consisting of the following acreage in the Undesignated West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool (79680):

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM

Irregular Section 30: Lots 1 and 2 and the E/2 NW/4 (NW/4 equivalent).

This unit is to be dedicated to Lance's proposed F-RPC "30" Well No. 2 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location, pursuant to Division Rule 104.C (3), revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, 910 feet from the North line and 1065 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Irregular Section 30.

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 104.D (2) and 104.F, as revised.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rules 104.D (2) (b) and 104.F (2), the above-described 92.30-acre non-standard Pictured Cliffs gas spacing unit and unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location for Lance's proposed F-RPC "30" Well No. 2 is hereby approved.
