REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL FOR NON-STANDARD LOCATION
FOR ELM RIDGE RESOURCES, INC.
SOUTH CARSON FEDERAL 25 #8 WELL
BASIN FRUITLAND FIELD & POOL
1650' FNL & 330' FEL SEC. 25, T. 25 N., R. 12 W., SAN JUAN COUNTY, NM

I. The well is on BLM surface and BLM oil and gas lease NMNM-25451. This existing well bore is standard for the Gallup. However, it will be plugged back and re-completed in the Fruitland coal to take advantage of the well bore which is no longer productive in the Gallup. Such a location location is non-standard for the Fruitland. A standard Fruitland location is 660' from the closest quarter section line. This well is 330' from the closest quarter section line.

II. A revised Form C-102 (Exhibit A) showing the well location and proration unit (N2 for the Fruitland) is attached. Two BLM leases will be communitized. The well is on NMNM-25451 which comprises 480 acres (S2N2 Sec. 25 + N2 Sec. 26). It will be communitized with BLM lease NMSF-078068-A which comprises 160 acres (N2N2 Sec. 25). Both leases (solid lines) and the communitized acreage dedication (dashed lines) are shown on the attached composite copy (Exhibit B) of the Alamo Mesa East and Carson Trading Post USGS topo maps.

III. According to NM Oil Conservation Division records; the closest existing or approved Fruitland coal gas well is Elm Ridge's Bisti Coal 36 #1. It is 4,876' south at 1165' FNL & 1220' FEL 36-25n-12w. Next closest existing or approved Fruitland coal gas well is Elm Ridge's existing Bisti Coal 23 #2. It is 10,316' northwest at 2510' FSL & 790' FWL 23-25n-12w. There are no existing or proposed Fruitland wells in Section 25, nor in a 4,876' radius.

A composite copy (Exhibit C) of the Alamo Mesa East and Carson Trading Post 7.5' USGS map is attached. The map shows the well site, existing (2) or proposed (1) Fruitland acreage dedications (dashed lines), and existing (2) or proposed (1) Fruitland well bores within the nine spot sections. There is only one lease within a minimum 330' radius. Elm Ridge is the operator of the Fruitland rights in the two BLM leases to be communitized. See Exhibit D for lease boundaries.

Registered letters were sent on May 3, 2003 to all offset interest owners. Copies of the letters and receipts are attached.

IV. A composite copy (Exhibit B) of the Alamo Mesa East and Carson Trading Post USGS maps is attached. The well site is marked. Proration unit for the Fruitland is the 320 acre north half of Section 25, Township 25 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, NM.

V. Elm Ridge selected its location to avoid disturbing new ground. BLM (surface manager) is trying to minimize new disturbance and Elm Ridge believes the Gallup potential in the existing well bore is exhausted.

VI. Archaeology is not an issue.

VII. See item V. above for a description of the surface conditions.

VIII. Directional drilling is not feasible because it is not cost effective.
