Burlington Resources is applying for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the Basin Fruitland Coal.

The subject well was staked at this location due to extreme topography in the northwest quarter. This site utilizes the existing Newco #1A (30-045-29801) located at 2535'FNL, 400'FWL in Section 20 and is on a terrace mesa overlooking a narrow canyon associated with Ditch Canyon, as shown on the attached topographic and aerial maps. The location could not be moved further east on the existing location due to the topography, in order not to create a large cut up to 15'.


Production from the Fruitland Coal is to be included in a 317.89 acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising of the west half of Section 20 and is to be dedicated to the Newco #100 (30-45-26995) located at 1630'FSL, 1640'FWL of Section 20.



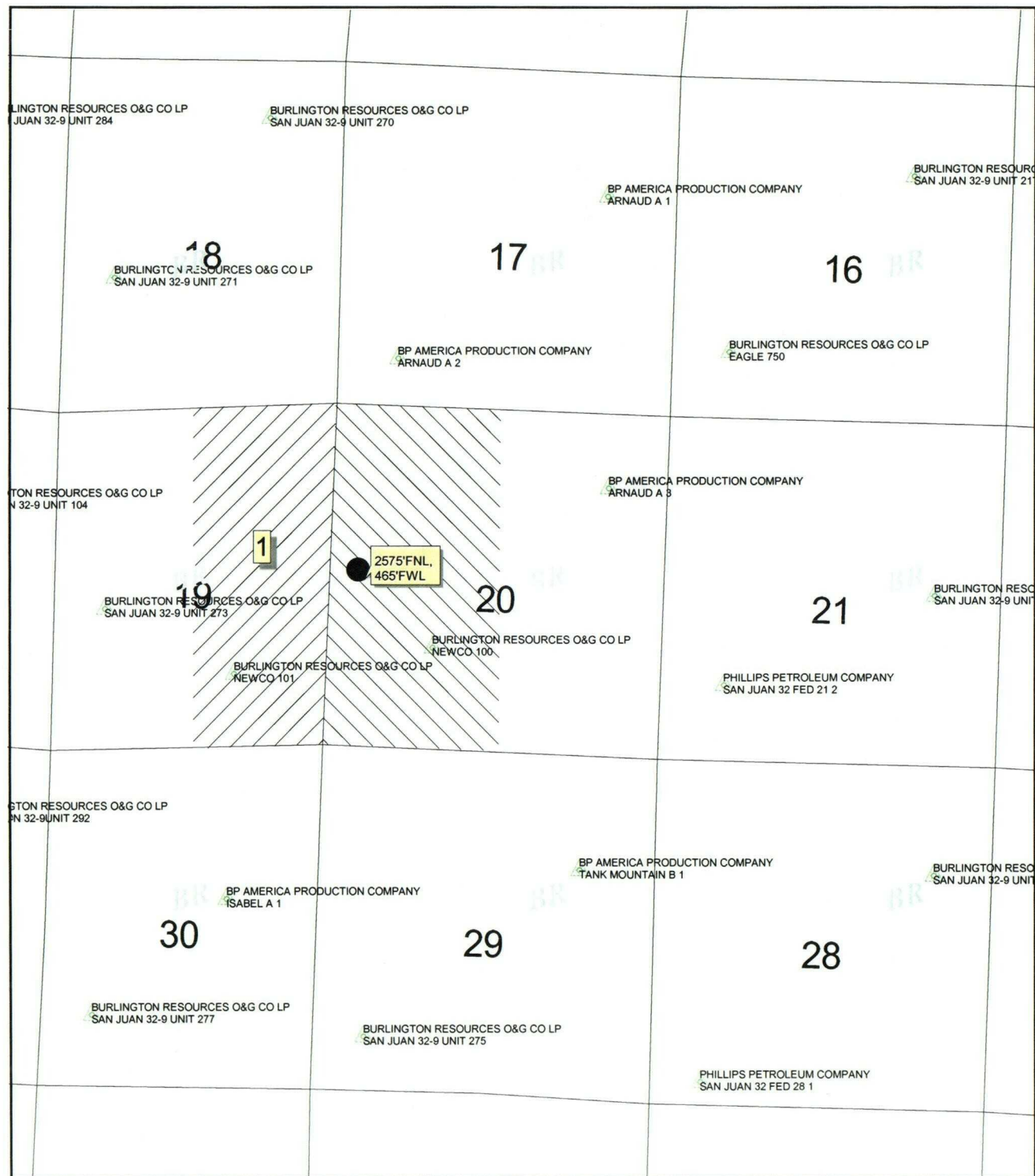

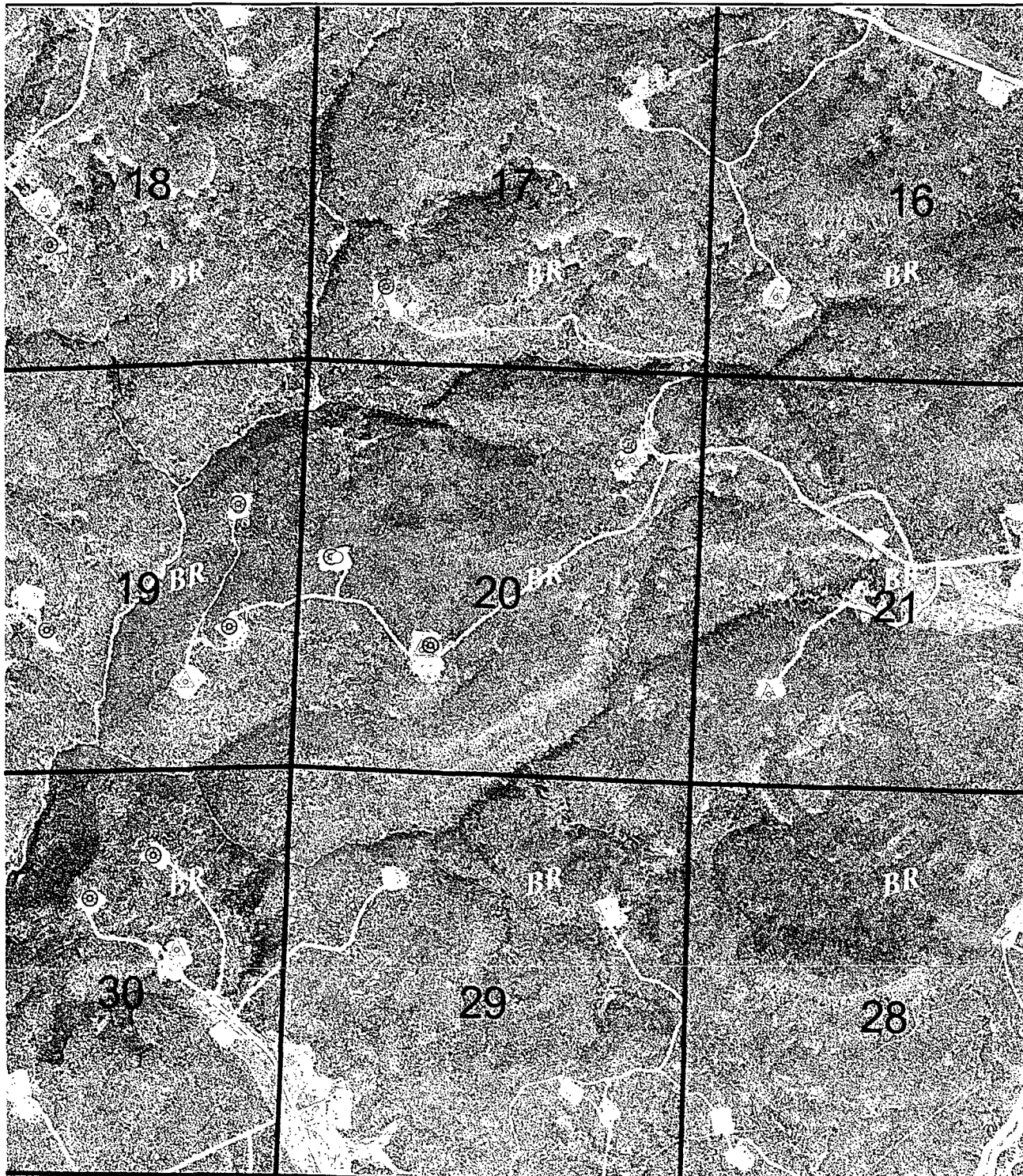
