
Dear Mike,

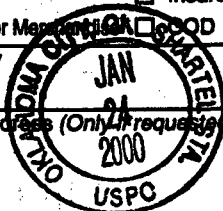
