The above referenced well is a Mesaverde/Dakota commingle. Attached is a copy of the allocation for the commingling of the subject well completed on August 15, 2003. DHC1034az was issued for this well.

Gas:	Mesa Verde Dakota	78% 22%
Oil:	Mesa Verde Dakota	78% 22%

These allocations are based on isolated flow tests from the Mesa Verde and Dakota during completion operations. Oil was not present during flow test operations. For that reason, oil percentages are based upon gas allocation and are provided in the event this wellbore begins producing oil at some point in the future.
