Reference is made to the following: (i) your initial application dated October 25, 1999; (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe ("Division"); (iii) your telephone conversation with Mr. Michael E. Stogner, Engineer/Chief Hearing Officer on Tuesday, November 2, 1999; and (iv) your supplemental information submitted by telefax on November 2, 1999: all concerning Dugan Production Corporation's request for an off-pattern non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for the proposed Dot Com Well No. 90 (API No. 30-045-29985) to be drilled 1850 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The S/2 of Section 2 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre lay-down gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
