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## MARTINEZ GAS COM G #1E N½, SEC. 24-T29N-R10W SAN JUAN CO., N.M.

### **GEOLOGIC SUMMARY**

The Martinez Gas Com G #1E is a well drilled in 1983 to a total depth of 6767 ft. which was initially completed in the Dakota Formation at a location 585' FNL, 1220' FWL of Section 24-T29N-R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is currently producing from the Dakota Formation only at a rate of around 170 MCFGPD. Cross Timbers Oil Company (CTOC) intends to re-enter the Martinez Gas Com G #1E, complete the Mesaverde Group Sandstone and commingle it with the existing Dakota Formation.

The Mesaverde Group consists of, from bottom to top, the Point Lookout Ss., a regressive coastal barrier sandstone that is continuous across much of the San Juan Basin, the Menefee Formation, a series of alternating sands, shales and coals deposited in an alluvial plain or coastal lagoon environment, and the Cliff House Sandstone, a NW-SE trending coastal barrier sandstone. In the immediate area, only the Point Lookout and Menefee Sandstones have proven productive. The Cliff House is believed to produce water. In the Martinez Gas Com G #1E the top of the Mesaverde Cliff House Ss. is at a depth of 3808 ft., the Menefee is at 3843 ft. and the Point Lookout occurs at 4426 ft.

There are currently three Mesaverde producing wells in Section 24; the CTOC Martinez Gas Com G #1 in the NE¼ which was completed in 1970 and has produced 1385 MMCFG up to 9/98, the CTOC Martinez Gas I #1A in the SE¼ which was completed in 1985 and has produced 300 MMCFG, and the CTOC Martinez Gas Com I #1 in the SW¼ which was completed in 1978 and has produced 369 MMCFG. There is currently no Mesaverde production in the NW¼ of Section 24. Burlington Resources operates one Mesaverde producing well in the S½ Section 13 to the north (Reid A #1M).

The existing Martinez Gas Com G #1E is at an unorthodox location (legal distance from the boundary of a Mesaverde GPU being 660 feet). Therefore, approval for an unorthodox location is necessary for the completion of the Mesaverde in this well.

With an estimated recompletion cost of \$125,700 vs. a new drill well cost of \$300,000, a savings of \$174,300 will be realized by recompleting the existing well rather than drilling a new well. In addition, the recompletion will prevent waste and additional surface disturbance associated with the drilling of a new well.


