Reference is made to your amended application received on September 9, 2013.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the special rules for the Bell Lake; Bone Spring Pool (Order R-4539-A), which provide for 160-acre units, with wells located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the quarter section and no closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section inner boundary. This location is also governed by Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because the terminus of the proposed completed interval is less than 660 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for engineering reasons.



Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
