
The Engineering Bureau (OCD Santa Fe) recently received two applications for lease commingling of wells which appear in both applications. The two applications received were as follows:

1. Sundry Notice (dated August 14th) and a June 24th correspondence requesting the surface commingle of State Lease E-33 B-11297 and State Lease E-28 E-5146. This application identified four individual wells: State E 33-1, State E 33-3, State E 28-1, and State E 28-2.
2. Sundry Notice (dated August 16th) and an August 24th correspondence requesting the surface commingle of State Lease E-33 B-11297, State Lease E-28 E-5146, and State Lease E-27 E-5146. This application identified five individual wells: State E 33-1, State E 33-3, State E 28-1, State E 28-2, and State E 27-1.

Is it the intent of Finley Resources to replace the newer application for the one submitted with the Sundry containing the four wells and is dated August 14th ? Additionally, has the State Land Office been notified of the proposed commingling? The Sundry notes that off-lease test separator to meter allocation from the State 33 lease before commingling with State 28 lease. Could you please provide additional information – a simple schematic/flow chart – to show the locations of wells/meters/leases. 
