I. The proposed Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) well is on Navajo allotted oil and gas lease NO-G-9602-1300 and Navajo allotted surface. The well is 405' from the closest lease line and 1,926' from the closest Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) well (Coleman's Leslie 2; 30-045-30552). The APD cover sheet is EXHIBIT A.

The well was initially planned to be staked at 1250 FSL & 660 FEL. However, that was too close to a house and power line. The well was then staked at 1020 FSL & 660 FEL to comply with BIA's 500' offset policy from houses.

However, that location at 1020 FSL & 660 was forced to move because of the discovery of San Juan milkweed and an archaeology site (LA 43213). San Juan milkweed is a Federal and State Species of Concern. The Navajo Nation Natural Heritage Program places it in Group 4 and recommends avoidance by 50' to 200' depending on the Tribal biologist.

The well was next staked at 845 FSL & 959 FEL. However, the Navajo allottees rejected that because it was too close to a corral.

The well was finally staked at 1042' FSL & 405' FEL. The well is nonstandard to the east. It is 255' too far east. Acreage dedication will be a 319.43 acre east half stand up. Form C-102 is attached as EXHIBIT B.

Coleman requests a nonstandard location due to land use (houses, corrals, overhead 345 kV power line, single phase power line, pipelines (NTUA water and Enterprise gas), NAPI canal and siphon, roads, archaeology, and San Juan milkweed.

The communitized (NMNM-099331) 319.43 acres comprises two allotted leases in the east half of Section 6. A standard Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) location must be at least 660' from the outer boundary of the spacing unit according to Case 12888 Order R-8768-C.

No standard location could be found that satisfied the allottees, complied with BIA 500' offsets from houses, avoided 9 known archaeology

sites, avoided San Juan milkweed, avoided a 100' wide right-of-way for a 345 kV power line which crosses the center of the quarter section, avoided a NAPI canal and siphon, and avoided gas and drinking water pipelines.

II. EXHIBIT B (Form C-102) shows the proposed well location, spacing unit, and the two Navajo allotted leases within the spacing unit.

III. EXHIBIT C shows existing Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) wells and spacing units based on NMOCD on line records as of July 11, 2011. Well details are:

Two quarter sections (NW4 5-26n-12w and NW4 8-26n-12) that border the Stacey 2 S spacing unit do not have any approved, existing, or plugged Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) wells.

The west quarter corner of Section 5 is 1,648' distant from the Stacey 2 S. The southwest corner of the drilling window in the northwest quarter of Section 5 is 2,030' distant.

The northwest corner of Section 8 is 1,117' distant from the Stacey 2 S. The northwest corner of the drilling window in the northwest quarter of Section 8 is 2,008' distant.

- IV. EXHIBIT D shows the proposed well, proration unit, drilling window, and only existing well (Stacey 1) within the drilling window. Coleman's Stacey 1 is a WAW Fruitland Sand PC gas well. It is  $\approx 600$ ' northeast of 2 houses and  $\approx 900$ ' southwest of 3 houses. Coleman does not believe it is feasible to drill the Stacey 2 S from the Stacey 1 pad due to its proximity to homes and possible communication between zones.
- V. EXHIBIT E shows the approximate locations of a 345 kV power line, single phase power line, houses, corrals, NTUA water line, Enterprise gas line, NAPI canal and siphon, and slopes ( $\approx 80$ ' of relief inside the drilling window). EXHIBIT EE is a picture of a San Juan milkweed which forced a move.
- VI. Nine archaeology sites (H-26- 56, 57, 58, 59, 61, 62, 63, 64, and 212) have been found to date wholly in the southeast quarter. One other site (-55) overlaps the southeast quarter. The sites range in size from 1 to 10 acres. The proposed location is close enough to archaeology site H-26-57 (= LA 43213) that an archaeologist will install a protective fence as required by the BIA.



- VII. Four separate wells were staked by United Field Services over a nine month period in 2008-2009 in order to find a safe and suitable location for stake holders (e. g., allottees, right-of-way holders, archaeologist, botanist).
- VIII. Coleman does not believe directional drilling to a standard location is cost effective given current gas prices.
- IX. I hereby certify that Coleman Oil & Gas, Inc. and its communitized interests have 100% of the Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) working interest in the communitized area which comprises the proposed 319.43 acre spacing unit and that the information is current and correct.

I hereby attest that I, on or before the date that the application was submitted to the Division, sent notification to the affected persons per 19.15.4.12 A. (2) and 19.15.15.13 C. NMAC by certified mail, return receipt requested (see EXHIBIT F), advising them that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing within 20 days from the date the division receives the application.
