EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Ross Draw 8 Fed 4H Well** to be completed within the Jennings; Bone Spring, West Pool (Pool Code 97860) underlying Section 8, Township 26 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 333 feet from the North line and 613 feet from the West line of Section 8. The upper most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1100 feet from the West line (Unit D) and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 1100 feet from the West line (Unit M). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, this well will be unorthodox because it's proposed location will be closer than 330 feet to the eastern boundary of the spacing unit. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will prevent waste of a productive reservoir and improve well performance.

Exhibit A is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Ross Draw 8 Fed 4H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the Southeast, East and Northeast.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Section 8 and the surrounding sections that depicts the proposed **Ross Draw 8 Fed 4H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.

Exhibit C is a list of parties affected by the encroachment to the Northeast and East. There are no affected parties to the Southeast since EOG is the sole operator and mineral lessee of the



federal lease covering Section 17. Nonetheless, a copy of this application has been provided to the Bureau of Land Management.




