Mr. Jones,

This is a formal notification for our discharge of hydrostatic test water discharge that is to take place on July 1, 2014. We plan on discharging around 5,000 gallons of freshwater from our newly constructed pipeline. The fluid will be discharged on property that is owned by Crestwood New Mexico Pipeline LP. The discharge will flow through a straw bale check dam to aid in aeration and prevent sediment runoff and erosion. The water is to be purchased from a local municipal water source. The discharge is not capable of reaching any surface waters of the state. There is a playa lake 1,800 feet to the east southeast however it has been determined that water will not reach this water feature.

Mr. Jones,

This is a formal request for an Annual Temporary Permission to Discharge hydrostatic test waste water from new pipelines generating less than 25,000 gallons per test. It is understood that by receiving an Annual Temporary Permission to Discharge we must meet the following conditions whenever we perform a discharge under the permit to be issued.

- a. the volume does not exceed 25,000 gallons per hydrostatic test;
- b. water from a public/municipal water supply or other OCD approved sources is used for each test;
- c. oral or written notification must be provided to the OCD 72 hours prior to each hydrostatic discharge event;
- d. the discharge does not enter any lake, perennial stream, river or their respective tributaries that may be seasonal;
- e. no discharge shall occur:
 - i. where ground water is less than 10 feet below ground surface.
 - ii. within 200 feet of a watercourse, lakebed, sinkhole or playa lake;
 - iii. within an existing wellhead protection area;
 - iv. within, or within 500 feet of a wetland; or
 - v. within 500 feet from the nearest permanent residence, school, hospital, institution or church;
- f. best management practices must be implemented to contain the discharge onsite, does not impact adjacent property, and to control erosion;
- g. the discharge does not cause any fresh water supplies to be degraded or to exceed standards as set forth in Subsections A, B, and C of the 20.6.2.3103 NMAC (the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations);

- h. the landowner(s) of each proposed discharge and/or collection/retention or alternative discharge location must be properly notified of the activities prior to each proposed hydrostatic test event; and
- i. an annual report, summarizing all tests of new pipe with less than 25,000 gallons per hydrostatic test event, will be submitted to the OCD within 45 days after the temporary permission expiration date and shall contain the following information:
 - i. the location of hydrostatic test (Section/Township/Range or GPS coordinates);
 - ii. the date of each test;
 - iii. the volume of each discharge; and
 - iv. the source and quality of test water (laboratory analysis, if necessary)

In the May 2, 2014 submittal we included the \$100.00 filing fee. I am including the \$150 temporary annual fee with this revised submittal.

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
