The proposed discharge/collection/retention location is on private property, located within NE/4 and SE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 15, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. OCD acknowledges the receipt of the filing fee (\$100.00) and the permit fee (\$600.00) for the permit from a submittal dated October 7, 2013.

Based on the information provided in the request, the hydrostatic test water discharge is hereby approved with the following understandings and conditions:

- 1. Enterprise shall comply with all applicable requirements of the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations (20.6.2 NMAC), the Oil and Gas Act (Chapter 70, Article 2 NMSA 1978), and all conditions specified in this approval and shall operate and close the project in accordance with the October 7, 2013 request;
- 2. Enterprise will be testing a new 12-inch diameter natural gas gathering system transmission pipeline approximately 9.1 miles (48,048 feet) long, located approximately 8 miles southeast of Loving, New Mexico;
- 3. Enterprise will acquire the hydrostatic test water from the City of Carlsbad, New Mexico;

- 4. Enterprise will generate approximately 300,000 gallons of hydrostatic test wastewater from the test event. The hydrostatic wastewater will remain in the pipeline while being sampled and transferred into frac tanks while awaiting test results from a certified laboratory;
- 5. Enterprise will slowly discharge the wastewater, via a system of flexible hoses and temporary piping, into twelve (15) 21,000 gallon frac tanks for temporary storage on the private property, in order to await test results from a certified laboratory:
- 6. Enterprise shall ensure that the temporary storage tanks shall have impermeable secondary containment (e.g., liners geomembrane and berms hay bales or a secondary containment tank), which will contain a volume of at least one-third greater than the total volume of the largest tank or one-third greater than the total volume of all tanks that are inter-connected, whichever is greater;
