
The commingled oil and gas production shall be measured and sold at the Lone Tree Draw State Well No. 2H Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit D, Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Oil and gas production from each well shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
