Chevron U.S.A. Inc. requests an amendment to Division Order No. CTB-685 to add the Hayhurst 16 25 27 State Well No. 3H well to the existing order. This request is approved, and Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (OGRID 4323) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Wildcat G-02 S2527 15A; Bone Spring (97816), and from the following leases and wells:

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Hayhurst 16 25 27 State Well No. 1H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit C, Section 16, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.


This order supersedes Order No. CTB 685, issued November 12, 2013.
