The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Noose Federal Well No. 10H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit O, of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production for the Noose Federal Com. Well No. 9H, Noose Federal Com. Well No. 10H, and Noose Federal Com. Well No. 11H wells shall be continuously metered before commingling. The oil and gas production for the Noose Federal Com. Well No. 2H and the Noose Federal Well No. 6H shall be measured with well testing before commingling. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


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The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management before commencing commingling operations.
