The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Avocado BRO State Well No.1H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit D, Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from the Avocado BRO State Well No.1H and Guava BRU State Well No. No.1H wells shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.


The gas production from the Mango BRM State Well No.1H and Tangerine BRT State Well No. No.1H wells shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the New Mexico State Land Office (NMSLO) before commencement of the commingling operations.
