

NOTICE is hereby given that Chevron Midcontinent, L.P., 15 Smith Road, Midland, Texas 79705, as Operator of the Lovington Paddock Unit (LPU) and the Lovington San Andres Unit (LSAU) in Lea County, New Mexico has filed an Application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval for the Surface Commingling of the gas production only. The proposed surface commingling will entail the installation of two allocation meters at the existing battery locations for each Unit, a single compressor and installation of a single sales meter to eliminate the extra sales line. The purpose is to reduce the surface facility footprint and improve the operation of the mature Units. The batteries for both the LPU and LSAU are located in the NE/4 of Section 1, T-17-S, R-36-E. Chevron Midcontinent, L.P. (Chevron) as Operator of the Lovington Paddock Unit (LPU) and the Lovington San Andres Unit (LSAU) is hereby proposing the surface commingling for the **Gas Production Only** from the LPU & LSAU in Lea County, New Mexico. The plan for the surface commingling for the LPU & LSAU will be as follows:

1. Two (2) allocation meters will be installed at the existing battery location for each Unit, one for the LPU and one for the LSAU;
2. A single compressor will be installed that will commingle the gas downstream of the meters;
3. A single sales meter will be installed that will eliminate the extra sales line; and
4. The allocation of production & revenue will be based on the volumes of gas production from all the wells in each Unit as measured through the two allocation meters.





Figure 2 - New Design and layout

An AFE for the facility upgrades for the surface commingling will follow by separate package once we have approval. I have attached Figure 2 – New Design and Layout as well as a Map showing the two overlapping Units and the location for the surface commingling for your convenience.

Mr. McMillan,

By telephone conversation of Monday, May 2, 2016, Mr. David Catanach spoke with Mr. Macurdy inquiring about how revenue is allocated to the interest owners in the Lovington Paddock Unit (LPU) and the Lovington San Andres Unit (LSAU) which were the subject of the recent approved Surface Commingling **for the gas production only from the LPU & LSAU**. The question on the allocation of the revenue (allocation of Unitized Substances) for the LPU & LSAU was referred to me for response.

There are two (2) allocation meters, one for the LPU and one for the LSAU which meter the volumes of gas from each Unit. A single compressor commingles the gas downstream of these meters which is sold at a single sales meter (see 1st attachment). The revenue from the sales of the gas is apportioned among and located to the committed Tracts in accordance with the respective Tract Participations as set forth in the schedule of participation in Exhibit "B" of the Unit Agreement for the Lovington Paddock Unit dated June 1, 1966, Effective October 1, 1966 and the schedule of participation in Exhibits "C-1" & "C-2" of the Unit Agreement for the Lovington San-Andres Unit dated April 16, 1962, Effective August 1, 1962.

This is a brief summary of how the revenue is allocated between the LPU and LSAU. I have attached a Pre-Application to Commingle that was sent to Mr. Martinez, New Mexico State Land Office which was acceptable and a Map of the overlapping Units which shows the Surface Commingle Site which I hope are of some help.

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management and the New Mexico State Land Office before commencing commingling operations.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
