Dear Mr. Moore:

On March 31, 2001 the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Navajo Refining Company's (the Permittee) March 29, 2011 letter requesting that the date for submittal of the Work Plan to investigate the eastern and southeastern portion of the refinery boundary be moved from April 4, 2011 to July 5, 2011. The Permittee have discovered additional information, including boring logs and electromagnetic surveys, potentially relevant to the study that was not previously submitted to NMED. Additional time is necessary to develop a conceptual site mode in the Work Plan using the additional information.

Navajo has shown good cause for the request, and NMED therefore hereby approves it. The Work Plan must be submitted to NMED no later than **July 5, 2011**.
