Dear Mr. Goetze,

Chevron USA Inc. hereby protests the above-referenced Administration Application to Inject filed by Solaris Water Midstream LLC's Brantley 22 SWD No.1 well. Applicant seeks to dispose of up to 40,000 BPD of fluids into the Devonian-Fusselman formations between 13,725' and 14,725'.

Chevron is an "affected person" under Rule 19.15.26.7(A) which was provided notice of the Application.

Chevron believes that granting of the Application will cause waste and impair its correlative rights. As an oil and gas operator with a full field development plan for its acreage in this area, granting the Application will prevent and/or limit the location and injection capacity of Chevron's SWD wells on its acreage, drive up disposal costs and delay or prevent development due to NMOCD's well proximity policy for SWD wells. Additionally, the Application is insufficient in that it does not demonstrate the training, knowledge of experience of the person who is offering the scientific geologic and engineering opinions contained in the Application and further lacks all of the information required by Division form C-108.

Chevron hereby requests that the applications be set for hearing in accordance with Rule 19.15.26.8(D) and, after appropriate notice and hearing, be denied. A paper copy of this letter has also be sent.
