## Re: Application of Tap Rock Operating, LLC, for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Gipple Fed Com #138H Well in the E/2 E/2 of Sections 28 and 33, Township 24 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Ms. Sandoval:

Tap Rock Operating, LLC ("Tap Rock") (OGRID No. 372043) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Gipple Fed Com #138H Well** (API No. 30-025-46670) to be completed within the WC-025 G-07 S243517D; Middle Bone Spring Pool (48294) underlying the E/2 E/2 of Sections 28 and 33, Township 24 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

This well will be drilled from a <u>surface location</u> 175 feet from the south line and 645 feet from the east line (Unit P) of Section 33, to a <u>bottom hole location</u> 5 feet from the north line and 51 feet from the east line (Unit A) of Section 28. The <u>first take point</u> will be located 100 feet from the south line and 51 feet from the east line (Unit P) of Section 33 and the <u>last take point</u> will be 100 feet from the north line and 51 feet from the east line (Unit A) of Section 28.

Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for the **Gipple Fed Com #138H Well** is unorthodox because the completed interval is closer than the standard offsets to the eastern boundary of the spacing unit in Sections 27 and 34, the northeastern boundary of the spacing unit in Section 22, and the southeastern boundary of the spacing unit in Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 35 East. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow Tap Rock to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.

**Exhibit A** is a Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Gipple Fed Com #138H Well** encroaches on the spacing units to the east, northeast, and southeast.

**Exhibit B** is a land plat that shows the proposed **Gipple Fed Com #138H Well** in relation to the adjoining spacing units to the east in Sections 27 and 34, the northeast in Section 22, and the southeast in Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 35 East.

Ownership is diverse between the subject spacing unit and the tracts to the east in Section 34. A copy of this application with all attachments has been sent by certified mail to each affected party advising them that if they have an objection it must be filed in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives the application.

**Exhibit** C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the east, which includes the Bureau of Land Management, together with the tracking information reflecting notice has been provided to those parties.



#### Re: Non-Standard Location Request Gipple #138H, (the "Well")

Dear Ms. Sandoval:

Tap Rock Operating hereby requests administrative approval of a non-standard location for the Well referenced above by decreasing the East-West footages from 330 feet to 50 feet from the eastern boundary of Section 33, T24S R35E. The Well is located in the WC-025 G-07 S243517D; MIDDLE BONE SP (Pool Code 98294). It is Tap Rock's responsibility as a prudent operator to optimize well spacing. Decreasing the distance from the boundary of the section by 280 feet increases ultimate recovery of reserves and thereby prevents waste of natural resources.
