Resending the email will not be necessary, but going forward please use the OCD. Engineer email address for all general correspondence with the bureau.

With regards to the previously proposed question; if the new AOR maps show that new affected parties are created by the move, then the move constitutes a material change to the application, and the application will need to be withdrawn. If this is the case, notify the OCD to withdraw the application and submit a new application with the modified location and affected parties through the OCD fee portal. In the new application scenario, the Devon protest should not be an issue.

If the modification does not result in new affected parties, then simply re-noticing the previously identified parties of the modification will suffice. However, even though Devon is no longer protesting the application as a result of the modifications, because a protest was formally lodged with the Division, the application must proceed through the hearing process in accordance with 19.15.26 (D) NMAC. In this case the Division will schedule the application for a hearing, but if AWR would like to apply for a hearing earlier that is also acceptable. In the event of a hearing, the application may be presented by affidavit if Devon is no longer protesting the application and there are no other entries of appearance.
