Dear Director Sandoval:

I am writing on behalf of Kaiser-Francis Oil Company, an affected party under the Division's rules, to object to the above-referenced administrative applications for approval of unorthodox well locations. Each well is located in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Code 98220). As the applications recognize, the Division has issued special pool rules that require wells located in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool to comply with 330' setback requirements. The first and last take points for the proposed wells do not comply with these requirements and are located only 100' from the South and North lines.

The applications do not meet the requirements of NMAC 19.15.15.13, as they fail to establish that an exception to the Division's special pool rules is necessary to prevent waste or protect correlative rights. Further, granting the applications would result in inconsistent policies and unfairness to other operators in the area who have complied with the Division's setback
