**Olive Branch SWD Federal #1:** This is an application for a Deep SWD that was received by OCD on March 22, 2019 (pMAM1908153552). It was protested by Solaris and went to hearing. After the hearing, OCD issued Findings of Fact on August 16, 2019 stating that “based on the technical criteria of proximity, the Olive Branch Federal SWD Well No. 1 would be the preferred application for approval of the authority to inject.” The document with the Findings of Fact is attached.
