PLC-654 does not have infill wells pre-approved currently; as such it will need to be amended. Please submit an application to amend the order as a C-107B within the application portal.

Presuming that you take advantage of the identical ownership to not provide notice to the interest owners, you will not be able to get approval for the addition of leases and pools with reduced notice requirements via 19.15.12.10(C)(4)(g) NMAC. However, this will not preclude you from receiving pre-approval for infill wells within the approved pools and leases provided that you request such within the application. Such pre-approval would then allow for future infill wells to be added via the C-103Z route.
