Reference is made to your application received on December 21, 2020.

This vertical well was drilled at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by special rule R-4338, which provides for 80-acre units, with wells to be located within 150 feet from the center of a governmental quarter – quarter section or lot.

This well's take point is 351 feet outside of the set back requirements and will encroach to the southern boundary. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 11, encroachment to the NE/4 SE/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. The applicant is 100% working interest within the affected acreage tract. Therefore, the 20 - day public notice is not required.

Division understands that this non - standard location is requested to allow for the most efficient development of acreage within the Strawn formation underlying the S/2 NE/4 of Section 11. Thereby preventing waste.

Your application has been filed under Subsection 6 of Paragraph of Section (C) of 19.15.16.15 NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

Per Subsection B of 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Division approves this unorthodox location.

The above approvals are subject to your following all other applicable Division rules.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of further orders as Division deems necessary.
