This directional well was drilled at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by special pool rule, R - 6913, which provides for 80-acre units, with wells to be located at least 150 from the QTR/QTR section line.

This well's completed interval is as close as 56 feet to the northern boundary. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.
