

The leak was reported as being from hole developed in the bottom of the oil storage tank. We have lost 60 bbls of oil, and recovered 20 bbls of oil via Vac Truck. The leak was contained within the 50' X 50' firewalls at the battery. This site is located down State Rd 128 at MM 14 turn south on Pure Gold Rd. go south across 2nd cattle guard to 2nd rd. Turn right and go to battery. A Initial C-141 will be forth coming. Thanks
