("BOPCO") hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.15.13 and 19.15.16.14 for an unorthodox well location for its Poker Lake Unit Well No. 343H. This well will be located in Sections 26, 23 and 22, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and is to be drilled in the Delaware formation, Poker Lake Southwest Delaware Pool at a surface location and a penetration point 550 feet from the South line and 365 feet from the East line of Section 22 and a bottomhole location 240 feet from the South line and 100 feet from the East line of Section 26, Eddy County, New Mexico. 


