

Re: Application of Three Rivers Operating Company for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Eagle 2 State No. 301 vertical well in the Lea-Bone Springs Pool Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Ms. Bailey:

Three Rivers Operating Company ("Three Rivers") (OGRID No. 272295) hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.15.13 NMAC for an unorthodox well location for its Eagle 2 State No. 301 well to be located in Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed well is to be drilled vertically in the Lea-Bone Springs Pool to the Wolfcamp formation at a surface location 2,190 feet from the South line and 1,980 feet from the West line of said Section 2.

Enclosed please find **Exhibit A**, which is a land plat for Section 2 that shows the proposed non-standard location of the Eagle 2 State No. 301 well, and adjoining units and existing wells. The Lea-Bone Springs Pool rules mandate 80-acre spacing and proration units. See Order No. R-1827-A. The proposed location in the Lea-Bone Springs Pool is unorthodox because the pool is governed by a special pool rule which provides that the initial well on any 80-acre unit shall be located within 150 feet of the center of any quarter-quarter section on which the well is located. See id. The proposed location is unorthodox because it is not located within 150 feet of the center of the quarter-quarter section.

As demonstrated on the enclosed Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (C-102), **Exhibit B**, the proposed Eagle 2 State No. 301 well encroaches on the spacing and proration unit to the North. The well is proposed to be placed outside the surface location mandated by the Lea-Bone Springs Pool approximately 210 feet north of the quarter-quarter section center to avoid the offset Delaware formation operator's existing surface pit (Mobil Lea State No. 1, API# 30-025-31696).



Pursuant to 19.15.4.12(A)(2)(c) NMAC, affected parties are those towards whom the non-standard location encroaches. Here, the proposed location encroaches on the 80-acre spacing and proration unit to the North. The operator to the North is Three Rivers; however, because ownership is not common between the adjoining spacing unit and the spacing unit containing the proposed unorthodox well, then affected persons include working interest owners in that spacing unit. 19.15.4.12(A)(2)(b) NMAC. Therefore, Three Rivers has provided notice to Cimarex Energy Company. Three Rivers also is providing notice to the State Land Office because the Eagle 2 State No. 301 well, under State Lease LG-2750, encroaches upon a different State Lease, LG-2833, to the North. A copy of this application with all attachments was mailed to all notice recipients.




