Initially 600bbls were released inside of the tank battery walls and we were able to recover 500bbls with vacuum trucks. Most of the release was contained inside the facility; however, some fluid did overflow the walls and ran onto the location. The facility is lined with a 40mil plastic liner and the entire pad location is bermed. Contaminated material has been scraped from the pad location and hauled to disposal. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area on the pad location to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

On 12-16-11 at 12:00pm a spill was found on the SRO 102 SWD. 500bbls of produced water was found inside lined dike and 100bbls of produced water spilled outside of dike all on location. Entire location is bermed. The spill was caused by a faulty drain valve on the trucking off load filter pot and water from gun barrel backed up through filter pot. Vacuum truck picked up all standing fluid inside dike and on location. Contaminated gravel inside dike will be replaced and contaminated soil on location scraped up and removed. Will replace faulty valve with coated connections and check valve will be installed on gun barrel to keep water from backing up. We will follow up with a C-141.
